PROJECTS

***Mother's Love*, Short Film, Director — December 2023**

A mother grapples with her son's addiction and her unconditional love for him. Worked in coordination with USC, SAG-AFTRA, and a full crew to create this short film.

***A Level Playing Field*, Short Documentary, Director — February 2023**

A documentary focusing on the inequities in college athletics for women. The project features pro athletes such as Simone Jackson (US Women's U20 Soccer), and was produced by Natalia Bryant (Mamba Mambacita Foundation). Currently being developed into a documentary series.

***Chai Guys*, Podcast, Producer, Vanmoto Media — 2022-2023**
